### **Reviewer's report:**

"Participants had to 'self-test' which is how the test is used in a real world setting. We could not be completely sure that samples related to the participant. However, it would seem unlikely that many, if any, participants would send another person's sample back. This sentence seems odd to me, as in a real world patients would consult their physician and he would prescribe and/or take the blood sample. The sentence "Participants had to 'self-test' which is how the test is used in a real world setting" should be changed to : "Participants had to 'self-test'."

Please specify how many of the foods were tested individually and how many were as pool test. This is important for the understanding of your screening method.

**Level of interest:** An article whose findings are important to those with closely related research interests

**Quality of written English:** Acceptable

**Statistical review:** No, the manuscript does not need to be seen by a statistician.
